Karnataka high court grants interim bail to actor Darshan for six weeks in Renukaswamy murder case

BENGALURU: The Karnataka High Court on Wednesday granted interim bail for six weeks to jailed actor Darshan Thoogudeep Srinivas, accused in the Renuka Swamy murder case. Single-judge Justice S Vishwajith Shetty allowed the interim bail application filed by Darshan to enable him to undergo surgery. The High Court has directed Darshan to surrender his passport before the trial court. The court also directed him to appear before a hospital of his choice and submit a report of his medical condition within one week to the court, including details of treatment that he would have to undergo. Actor Darshan will come out of jail after 131 days. Reacting to the bail, counsel of actor Darshan Sunil Kumar said, "We will come to know only after we get the order copy, we will submit the passport, we have to fulfil some of the procedures for the release of Darshan on bail, we will do that." MP: Elephant death toll at Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve rises to eight, probe on

UMARIA: Death toll of elephants at Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve (BTR) located in Madhya Pradesh's Umaria district rose to eight, and one more is undergoing treatment, said P K Verma, Deputy director of BTR on Wednesday evening. On Tuesday four elephants, from a herd of 13 elephants, were found dead in the BTR while four others were found ill during the normal patrolling. On receiving the information, the forest official reached the spot and identified that it was a herd of 13 elephants. Among them two were normal and healthy while the treatment of remaining ill elephants were initiated, the officer said. He further said that during the treatment three more elephants died on Tuesday night and one more died on Wednesday, taking the toll to eight.
